Last summer ECDC submitted a hybrid planning application for the c.44 acre masterplan, and are now midway through the planning determination process.

Philippa Illingworth, Infrastructure Director at The Earls Court Development Company, said: "Joining The Earls Court Development Company to lead the infrastructure team is an exciting opportunity to tackle the complex engineering challenges of this iconic site. From coordinating development alongside operational rail assets, substructures, and bridges to delivering the new infrastructure needed for the proposed development and green spaces, this role offers a chance to contribute to the transformation of Earls Court.
